


# How to Draw a Pumpkin




# 1. Draw the middle of your pumpkin.

Make a long oval, however tall you want your pumpkin to be.




# 2. Make the sides of your pumpkin.

Draw a rounded line on either side of your oval.




# 3. Keep making the sides of your pumpkin.


# 4. Add your stem.






# 5. Add decoration!

Decorate the background of your pumpkin or add vines to your pumpkin. Color once finished.










### Fall Mad Lib

#### FALL TRIVIA

#### What is fall?

Fall marks the change from summer to winter. You may notice that it becomes colder and windier outside and the leaves begin to change colors!

#### When is fall?

Fall begins on September 22 and ends on December 21. That is about 91 days of fall! Wow! During fall, Daylight Savings Time in the United States ends, and our clocks turn back one hour. Some people call this change "Fall back."


#### What fruit is the freshest in the fall?

While Americans typically refer to this season as "fall", the British commonly use the word "autumn". Which word will you use?




