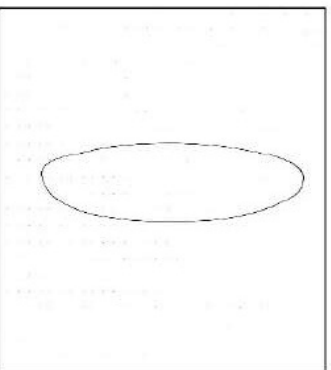


# How to Draw a Pumpkin



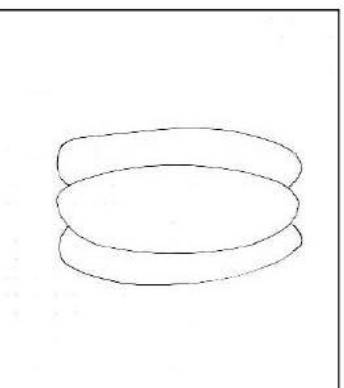
**1. Draw the middle of your pumpkin.**

Make a long oval, however tall you want your pumpkin to be.



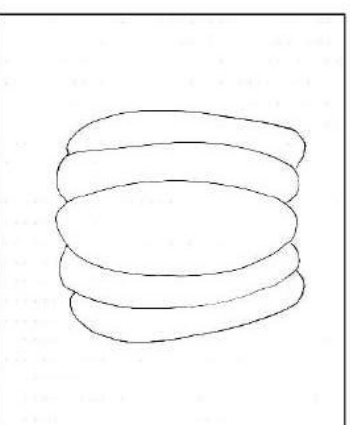
**2. Make the sides of your pumpkin.**

Draw a rounded line on either side of your oval.



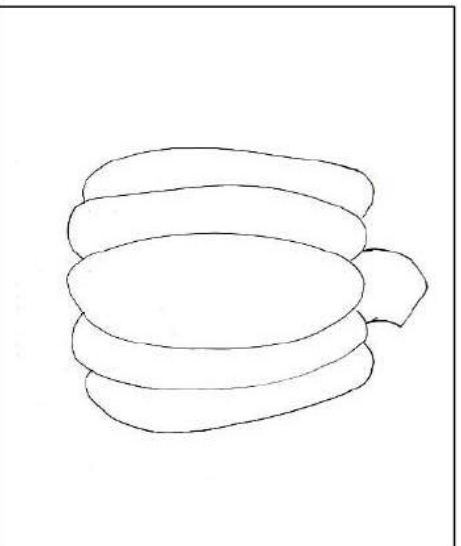
**3. Keep making the sides of your pumpkin.**

Draw another rounded line on either side of your new lines. Your pumpkin



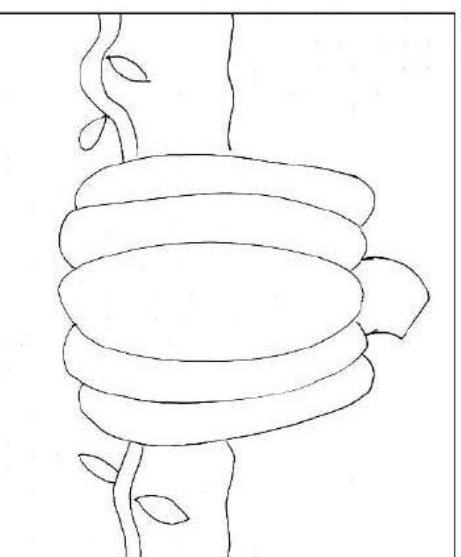
**4. Add your stem.**

Draw two vertical lines from the middle of the two ovals closest to the middle oval. Curve the ends and connect with a diagonal line.

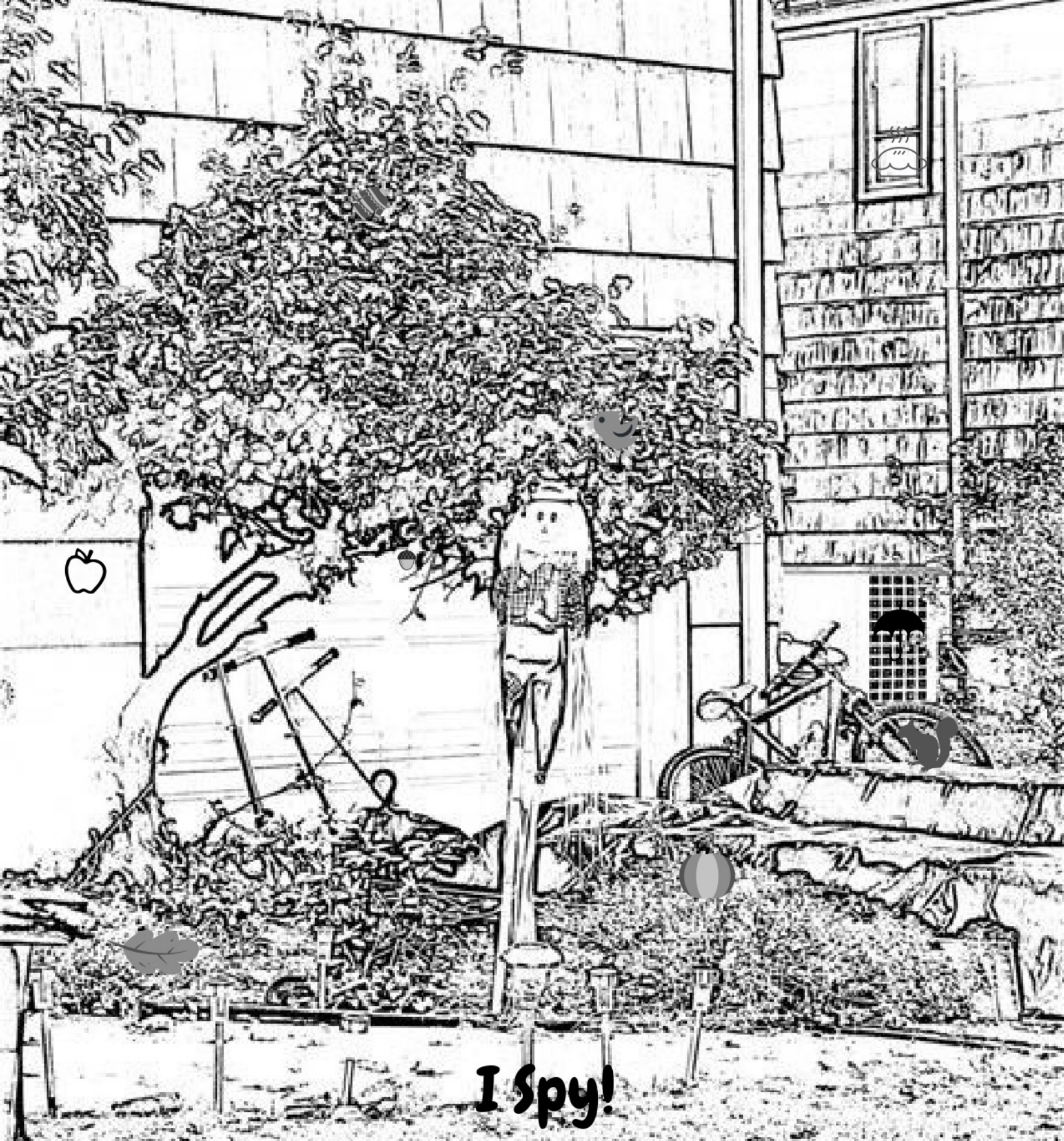


**5. Add decoration!**

Decorate the background of your pumpkin or add vines to your pumpkin. Color once finished.

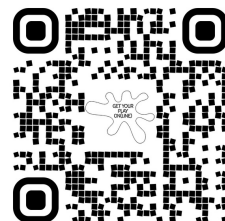


# Fall Mad Lib

# FALL TRIVIA

Let's learn about fall by reading some super cool facts about the season! You can also read these facts to the people around you to quiz them about their fall knowledge! Ready to learn?

## **What is fall?**

Fall marks the change from summer to winter. You may notice that it becomes colder and windier outside and the leaves begin to change colors!

## **When is fall?**

Fall begins on September 22 and ends on December 21. That is about 91 days of fall! Wow! During fall, Daylight Savings Time in the United States ends, and our clocks turn back one hour. Some people call this change "Fall back."

## **Why does it get cold?**

During fall and winter, the Earth (that is the planet we live on) tilts further and further away from the Sun. The Sun is what keeps our planet nice and warm! For us in the Northern Hemisphere (the top half of the Earth), it gets colder during Fall, but in the Southern Hemisphere, the weather actually gets warmer!

## **What's so sweet about Candy Corn?**

Do you love to snack on Candy Corn during the fall? You are not alone! Candy Corn even has its own special day, Candy Corn Day, that is celebrated on October 30th!

## **Where do pumpkins grow?**

You may have noticed people love to decorate for fall with pumpkins. Maybe you have even visited a pumpkin patch before! But where do pumpkins grow? Six of the seven continents on Earth grow pumpkins. The poor penguins in Antarctica don't get to see pumpkins :(

## **What is the largest pumpkin ever grown?**

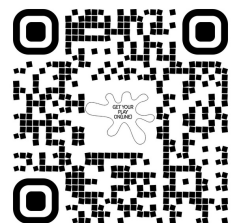

Apples! In the fall, apples are the crispiest, crunchiest, and juiciest!

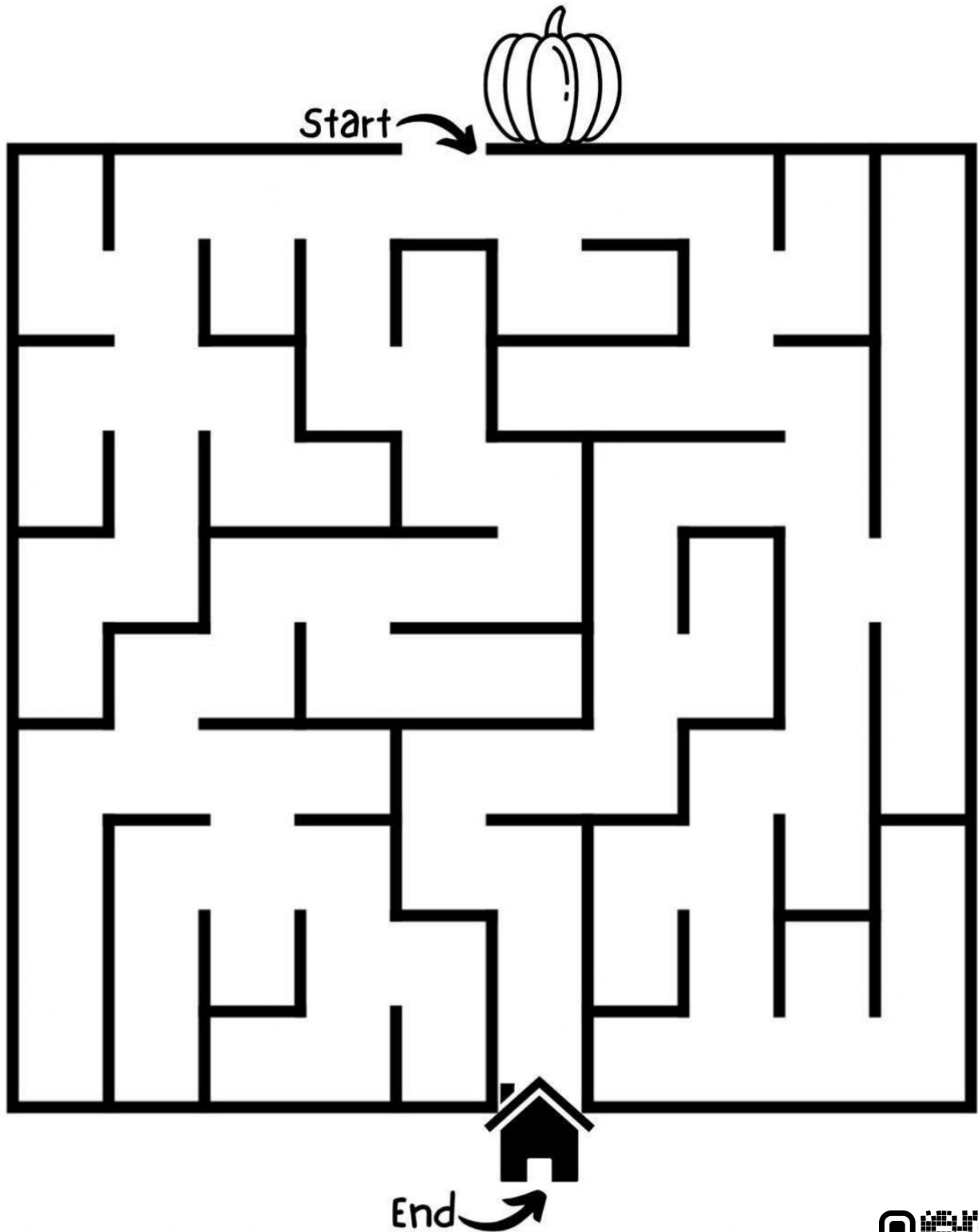
## **What's Autumn?**
